Further, to reduce leakages in the Supplementary Nutrition Programme, a facial recognition system has been introduced to ensure that eligible beneficiaries alone receive nutrition support.

Beyond nutrition, the Ministry ic ensuring cafety and support for women through technology-led platforms. The SHe Box postal provides single-window access to every weman to lodge complaints under the Sensal Harassment of Women at Workplace Prevention Prohibition and Redressal) Act. 2013. It enables online redressal and tracking, Meanwhile, the Mission Shakti dashboard and mobile app provide integrated assistance to women in distress connecting them to the nearest one stop centre, now operational in nearly every district. These interventions exemplify how technology is being used not just for efficiency, but for justice, dignity, and empowerment.

The Modi government has also operationalised the Pradhan Mantri Natru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) - a game changer in maternal welfare. Under the PMMVY Rules, 2022, pregnant women receive \$5000 for their firstchild, Under Mission Shakti. the benefit extends to \$6,000 if the record child is a girl pronoting positive reinforcement in daughters. Delivered through a paperless Direct Beneft Transfer system, about \$19,000 crore has

reached over 4 crore women beneficiaries since its inception. PMMVY is a fully cigital

Cabinet approves Employment-Linked Incentive scheme for formal job creation

WITH AN objective to boost employment generation in formal sectors, especially in manufacturthe Employment Linked Incentive (ELI) scheme on Tuesday. The scheme, which was announced in the Union Budget for 2024-25, presented in July 2024, has an outlay of Rs 99,446 crore and aims to create 3.5 crore iobs over a period of two years.

The Union Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, approved the ELI scheme to "support employment generation, enhance employability and social security across all sectors, with special focus on the manufacturing sector", an official statement said. Information & Broadcasting have two parts - part A for first timers and part B for sustained employment.

Part A of the scheme focuses on first-time employees by providing them a wage subsidy of up ing, the Union Cabinet approved to one month's wage, up to a maximum amount of Rs 15,000. while Part B of the scheme has incentives for employers to create additional employment. Out of the total 3.5 crore employees expected to benefit from the scheme, around 1.92 crore persons are seen to be first timers entering the workforce.

Targeting first-time employees registered with the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO), Part A will offer one-month EPF wage up to Rs 15,000 in two installments. *Employees with salaries up to Rs 1 lakh will be eligible. Part B of the scheme is for generation of additional employment in all sectors, with a special focus on the manufactur-The employers will get incen-

tives for employees with salaries up to Rs 1 lakh. "The government will incentivise employers, up to Rs 3,000 per month, for two years, for each additional employee with sustained employment for at least six months. For the manufacturing sector, incentives will be extended to the third and fourth years as well," the statement said. For EPF wage slab of additional employee up to Rs 10,000, an incentive of Rs 1,000 will be given to the employer, for wage slab of over Rs 10,000 and up to Rs 20,000, a benefit of Rs 2.000 will be given and for wage over Rs 20.000 (up to salary of Rs 1 lakh/month), an incentive of Rs

registered with EPFO, will be required to hire at least two additional employees (for employers with less than 50 employees) or five additional employees (for employers with 50 or more employees), on a sustained basis for at least six months, it said.

All payments to the first-time employees under Part A of the scheme will be made through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode. Payments to the employers under Part B will be made directly into their PAN-linked accounts. The duration of the scheme will be for two years from August 1, 2025 to July 31, 2027.

The ELI scheme was first announced by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in Budget 2024-25 as part of the Prime Minister's Package for Employment and Skilling that had a Budget outlay of Rs 2 lakh

- □ Incentive structure: First installment after 6 months, second after 12 months and financial literacy training, ensuring sustained formal employment.
- ☐ A portion of the incentive is deposited in a **fixed account** to promote **long-term savings**, enhancing financial security for employees.
- ☐ Payments directly transferred via **Direct Benefit Transfer** to the employee, ensuring transparency and efficiency.

FORMAL EMPLOYMENT IN INDIA



Railway launches RailOne app

Railways launches RailOne app to ease ticket booking, travel services

NEW DELHI

Union Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw on Tuesday launched a new app, RailOne, in New Delhi.

The app has been conceived by the Railways' public sector undertaking (PSU), the Centre for Railway Information Systems (CRIS). RailOne is focused on improving the passenger interface with the Railways, officials said.

"It is a comprehensive, all-in-one application with a user-friendly interface. The app is available for download on Android Play Store and iOS App Store," a Railways spokesperson said.

The RailOne app integrates all passenger services, including a 3% discount on unreserved tickets and platform tickets, live train

tracking, grievance redressal, e-catering, porter booking, and last-mile taxi services

"Reserved tickets will continue to be offered on IRCTC (the Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation, the PSU providing ticketing, catering, and tourism services for the Railways). The RailOne app has also been authorised by the IRCTC, just like many other commercial apps that have partnered with the IRCTC," the spokesperson added.

The RailOne app features a single sign-on with login via mPIN or biometrics. The app also supports existing RailConnect and UTS credentials. UTS is the Indian Railways' mobile ticketing application, which allows daily train travellers to book unreserved tickets.

RailOne saves space on devices as there is no need to install multiple apps, officials said.

Urging CRIS to focus on further strengthening the digital core of the Indian Railways, Mr. Vaishnaw also commended the CRIS team for the progress made on upgrading the existing passenger reservation system (PRS).

"The modern PRS will be agile, multilingual, and scalable to handle 10 times the current load. It will be capable of 1.5 lakh ticket bookings and 40 lakh enquiries per minute," the spokesperson said.
